

Welcome to a quick “How To” for working in the new NIST Module.

Let’s start with finding NIST SP 800-171. It used to be found under NIST SP 800-171 Assessment link however, with the new release SPRS Version 4.0, it is now located within the Cyber Reports (NIST) link in the left hand menu. There is a pull down menu to select the CAGE and a Run Cyber Reports button to bring a user into the NIST Assessments landing page. Once selected, the application would display the HLO Landing page with assessment counts. To find counts now on each CAGE, select the Overview tab. The numbers are also now linked, if selected it will bring the user to the Criteria Search screen with a list of the assessment scores against that CAGE and Confidence Level combination.

How do you enter an assessment score? A user still needs Cyber Vendor access, it is now easy to identify if a user has this role, by the asterisk placed next to the CAGE in the header. Also, the Add New NIST Assessment button is now up front on the landing screen, no longer does the user need to Create a New HLO CAGE Header and then enter a New NIST Assessment.

Once the Enter Assessment Details screen is open, the required information is identical in SPRS 4 in relation to the prior release.

Need to export a NIST Report? That looks a little different too. Prior to the new release, there was an Export HLO CAGE(s) to Excel on the Header View. Now, there is a tool bar that allows a user to use the Export option to send the report into the new Download module. This will keep the Exported report for five days.
