

Welcome to the SPRS Risk Analysis Report Teaser. This teaser will quickly preview upcoming changes for Government users to a few of the Risk Analysis Report modules: Supplier Risk, Item Price Risk, and Supplier Surveillance.

In Supplier Risk, users can now enter up to ten (10) Commercial and Government Entity (CAGE) Code(s) or Unique Entity Identifiers (UEIs). This report allows copy and paste of CAGE Code(s) or UEI(s). Click the 'X' within each tile to remove the selection prior to clicking search.

Searching multiple CAGEs or UEIs will allow the user to view supplier risk data side by side and in a chart format.

When running the Supplier Risk Report with multiple CAGEs or UEIs, a prepopulated table, and associated graph will appear containing supplier risk summary information for the CAGEs or UEIs entered. The table header includes Company Supplier Risk Score and Color, as well as SAM exclusion status.

Vendors can be added or removed using the checkboxes across the top, click Update Selected to update chosen CAGEs or UEIs. The checkboxes in the table can be used to add or remove Supplier Risk Factors from the corresponding graph below.

To view the classic single page Supplier Risk Report for a company, Click the "Details" button next to the CAGE/UEI in the menu across the top. Click the "Update Selected" button in the Entity Selections section to return to the multiple CAGE view.

When running the report by a single CAGE or UEI, the top section of the Supplier Risk Report shows Contractor Information and Restrictions in a new side-by-side table format. The Supplier Risk Color tiles are next. There is a new tile for Level III/IV (three/four) CARs. Followed by the 10 Supplier Risk Factors, which has a different look but still contains the same information and function.

The next report is the Item Price Risk Report, users are now able to search for a single NSN with a type-ahead feature. Start typing the NSN and the number will appear with a description of the item, click Submit.

Users can now search for multiple Material Ids, enter up to fifty (50) at a time. Copy and paste from a spreadsheet for best results. Once the list is entered, click Submit.

Running the report with multiple Material Ids, the Item Price Risk Report shows Lower and Upper Control Limits, Average Price, and if the item is High Risk.

If a record has information available in the SPRS database. Click on the check box in the far-left hand column to see the full Item Price Risk Report for the specific Material ID. If no information is available, there will be an indicator next to Part Number/NIIN and the line will not be expandable.

When running by a single Material Id, the report shows a classic Item Price Risk report with an updated look.

Last updated module is the Supplier Surveillance Report. Users now have the ability to type ahead for NSN and search by a numerical Supplier Risk Score range.

The look and feel of the Supplier Surveillance report has been refreshed to include easy display of search criteria and item risk details, along with additional data columns. The Commercial Risk Records column indicates if there are records available in SPRS Enhanced Vendor Profile (EVP) for any of our Commercial Data Sources. When searching by NSN there are now columns for Quality and Delivery Performance as well. Click the info buttons for additional information.

New in all the modules, Breadcrumbs for Navigation. Use Breadcrumbs to return to the previous page.

In addition, to obtain a spreadsheet of any of the reports, select the Export button from the Toolbar. An indicator will pop up indicating the request has been received, select Okay. The reports will be available in the Downloads center for five (5) days.

Select the Printer Icon from the toolbar to display a print friendly version of any of the new reports that may be printed or saved as PDF.
